



## Ten Rater World Championships Allocation of Places

### Stage One

7.2.1 In which no AM shall have an allocation of more than 8 places. The initial allocation of places shall be: -

- (i) a personal place for the previous champion; this place shall not be counted in any AMs total
- (ii) one to each qualifying AM,
- (iii) one place for the host AM,
- (iv) the EC may allocate places to competitors from non qualifying AMs, to a maximum of 2.
- (v) the remaining places shall be allocated to AMs according to the finishing order of boats from the AMs in the previous relevant championship.

### Stage Two

7.2.2 In which no AM shall have their allocation increased above 10 places.

If there are still places after the initial allocation

- (i) any available places shall be allocated to AMs that have sent in applications for additional places before the closing date, using the finishing order of boats from the AMs in the previous relevant championship.

- (ii) if there are still places available, those AMs still requiring places will be listed
- (a) in order of their highest finishing place in the previous relevant championship, followed by
  - (b) in reverse numerical order of their subscription category, those in the same category will be split by drawing lots. Places will then be allocated one per AM going down the list repeatedly until each AM reaches the stage 2 maximum allocation, or has the places applied for in 7.2.2 (i) if less.

### Stage Three

7.2.3 In which there is no restriction on the maximum number of places for any AM. If there are still places available, they shall be allocated one per AM to those AMs still wanting them, using the AM list described in 7.2.2 (ii). If any AM has requested places after the initial closing date, they should be added at this stage. 7.2.4

### Stage Four

7.2.4 If at any stage the maximum number of entrants is achieved, the organising authority shall notify at least the next five persons on the list 7.2.2(ii) informing them that they are a reserve should any AM reduce its places allocated in 7.2.1 to 7.2.3. If places become available immediately prior to the start of an event, the Organising Authority may make up the numbers to the entry limit, by informing the reserves and then continuing the allocation of places from the list referred to in 7.2.2 (ii).
